

Proceedings of the III Electron Magnetic Resonance Forum EMR-PL Kraków, Poland, 23–25 May 2014

Editorial

The Third Forum EMR-PL was held in Kraków, Poland, on 23–25 June 2014, continuing the spirit of the First (Rzeszów, 2010) and Second (Huciska, 2012) meetings. The Forum was organized under the auspices of the Polish Electron Magnetic Resonance Group (PG-EMR) by the Local Organising Committee (LOC) headed by Professor Zbigniew Sojka at the Faculty of Chemistry, Jagiellonian University. Detailed information can be found at: http://pgemr. org. The exceptional occasion of the 650th Jubilee of the Jagiellonian University added special importance to the Forum.

The main aim of the Forum was to bring together EMR spectroscopists working in Poland to facilitate scientific contacts and collaboration among this community. About 70 researchers participated giving 3 plenary lectures, 13 invited lectures, 20 oral talks, and 43 poster presentations. Two invited speakers from the USA: Jerzy Krzystek and Andrew Ozarowski, were guests of the Third Forum. There was also a joint session on theoretical and computational spectroscopy with MagComp FOKUS action of the National Leading Research Centre of the Faculty of Chemistry.

This Special Issue of "Nukleonika" contains selection of the papers presented at the Third Forum. It may serve as an overview of Polish activities and contributions to the EMR research community. Our sincere thanks go to all members of the Scientific Committee of the Third Forum EMR-PL for support in nominating the invited speakers and maintaining the high standard of this Forum as well as to other colleagues who have referred the submitted papers. Due to the efforts of the authors as well as the dedication of the reviewers and editors, this Special Issue satisfies the scientific and publishing standards.
